BOOKING CONDITIONS

- * I agree that the property is occupied only for a holiday and that, in no circumstances, will I exceed the period booked or the number of occupants specified above.
- * I agree that, once my booking has been confirmed, in the event of my cancellation I am liable to pay the following:
 - 15% of total rent if notification is more than 90 days before start date.
 - 25% of total rent if notification is 90-56 days before start date.
 - 50% of total rent if notification is 55-42 days before start date.
 - 100% of total rent if notification is less than 42 days before start date.
- * I understand that it is my responsibility to obtain adequate Personal and Cancellation Insurance as the use of the accommodation and amenities offered is entirely at my risk and that the owner cannot accept liability for injury to a user or visitor or loss or damage to the user's or visitor's belongings.
- * I agree to payment of the rental balance and breakages deposit 9 wks before the start of my holiday.
- * I agree to take good care of the property and to inform the owner of any breakages or damage that occurred during my stay.
- * I agree to leave the property in a clean, hygienic and tidy condition at the end of the rental period.
- * I understand that if the property is left in an excessively dirty or untidy condition then a deduction will be made from the breakages deposit to cover remedial costs.
- * I understand that my deposit will be returned to me, less any costs incurred, as soon as the telephone bill has been received—this can take two months.
- * I understand that, in the unlikely event of the owner having to cancel my booking for any reason beyond his control, all monies will be immediately returned and, if I so wish, every effort will be made to assist me to find accommodation in a similar property.
- * I understand that, if I have a complaint concerning the property, then I am requested to contact the owner directly and every effort will be made to rectify the defect.

GENERAL INFORMATION

START DATES

Start and end dates for your holiday are Saturday. Your choice of dates will be confirmed to you once your completed booking has been received.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

The property will be ready for you to take over at 5.00 p.m. on the start date of your holiday. Directions to the property and instructions concerning the handover of keys will be issued at the time of your final payment. In order to prepare the property for the next guests you are requested to vacate the premises by 10.00a.m. on the last day.

BREAKAGES DEPOSIT

A refundable deposit is payable with the final instalment of your rental payment. This amounts to £250.00 . The deposit, less any deductions for costs incurred or damage done, will be returned as soon as possible. One of the costs is the telephone for which France Telecom send a bill every two months. Thus, your patience is appreciated.

CLEANING STANDARDS

The property is cleaned and prepared for your arrival. You are asked to leave it and the contents as you would expect to find them. You are responsible for the cost of extra cleaning if the property is left in an unreasonable state. If you wish to have the property cleaned during your stay, at an extra cost, please apply to the owner.

ELECTRICITY

The cost of electricity is included in the rental charge. However, the owner reserves the right to charge for consumption exceeding 7.5euros per person per week (average consumption per person per week).

LINEN

Bed linen and towels are provided. Guests may wish to bring their own large beach towels for sunbathing.

SWIMMING POOL

The pool is available for your pleasure. It is regularly maintained and you will be given the name and number of the local company retained for this purpose. However, you are reminded that swimming pools are potentially dangerous places and you should take precautions, particularly :

- Check which end is shallow and which deep on arrival
- Always supervise children in the pool area
- Do not dive into the pool
- Do not take breakable glasses or other utensils into the pool area
- Do not use the pool whilst under the influence of alcohol
- Do not swim at night
- You are reminded that you, your party and your visitors use the pool at your own risk

PLEASE TAKE CARE

CARING FOR YOUR COMFORT AND SAFETY

The property has a house book containing useful information about the house, its facilities, names and telephone numbers of people who can help in an emergency, plus useful tips about the area, its restaurants and sights. Please study it on arrival.

It is recommended that you familiarise yourself with new surroundings. In particular :

- Make sure everybody knows their evacuation route in case of emergency
- Check the fire extinguishers and their operational instructions
